Position Description – Local Families | Family Pastor

Time: Full time position, 45 hours weekly (includes weekly, evening, and weekend hours)

Reports to: Toran Scott - Lead Pastor

Primary work relationships: Student and Children volunteers & Local Staff

Function: Combine the efforts of church and home to help kids and students fall more in love with Jesus. The Local Family Pastor oversees the development, vision, implementation, and execution of the ongoing ministries of Local Kids & Local Students on a weekly basis. The Family Pastor oversees the equipping, care, and training of Local Kids and Student volunteers. The Family Pastor is passionate about partnering with parents to help them raise their children to fall more in love with Jesus. Will constantly strive to help formation take root at church and in the home, while passionately communicating the gospel to parents, students, and children. Will work closely with TLC's Pastoral Staff to create unity and collaboration, to implement families, children, and students to the vision of the Church.

Responsibilities

Vision & Leadership

- Cast a compelling vision for the Family Ministries (parents, children & students)
- Recruit, support, train, and empower Local Kids & Students volunteers.
- Equip parents to step into their role as the primary influencer on the formation of their children
- Attend appropriate meetings with leadership and staff weekly
- Pastorally serve our church as needed (weddings, funerals, care, etc.)
- Option to be a part of the teaching team based on giftings and passion

Planning and Execution

Local Families

- Regularly communicate calendar and events to parents while providing encouragement and resources
- Provide learning environments and workshops for parents to connect and grow
- Partner with TLC pastors to create overlap, unity, and integration of ideas and resources for families
- Plan and oversee Child Dedication services and other Family Ministry Milestones and Rituals

Local Kids

- Recruit, develop, train, and partner with curriculum and teaching teams for Local Kids
- Make sure Orange curriculum is set for weekly gatherings
- Regular communication with parents (social media, newsletter, etc.)
- Organize and prepare all needed supplies and activities on a weekly basis (birth-5th grade)
- Schedule and maintain volunteers for Local Kids Ministry

Local Students

- Plan and oversee weekly gatherings, retreats, and events for students
- Develop and oversee ongoing discipleship and formation of students
- Create plan for engaging students in overall life of the church
- Partner with parents to help them disciple and release their kids towards college

Administration

- Timely respond to inquiries and questions about the family ministry
- Provide weekly follow up with new families to welcome and integrate them into the faith community
- Schedule all Local Kids volunteers, ensuring enough help for every worship service and special events
- Regularly communicate with ministry volunteers for direction, encouragement, and inspiration
