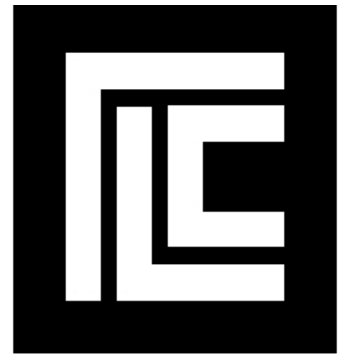


Birthday Party!

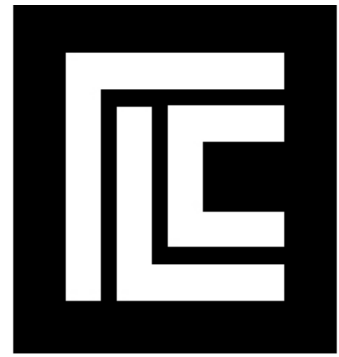
