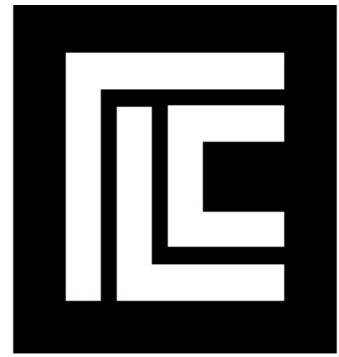


PB & J: Experiencing God in the Everyday & Ordinary
