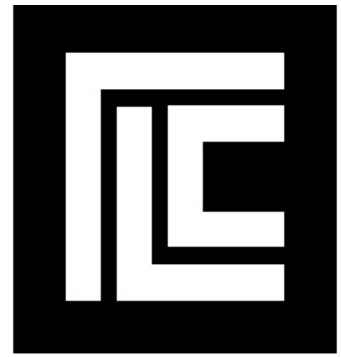


You Really Believe This? Where does the Bible come from?

2 Timothy 3:16-17



The Christian Canon is made up of 66 books, the Old Testament (39 books in Hebrew and Aramaic) and the New Testament (27 books in Greek). There has been consensus on this canon for many years. But where does it come from? On Sunday, Dr. Burge helped us understand this very question.

Digging Deeper

- Gary shared one hope with us: that we encounter the Bible as something that is living and active and shapes our lives. How has the Bible shaped your life in the past? How has it shaped your heart and life recently?
