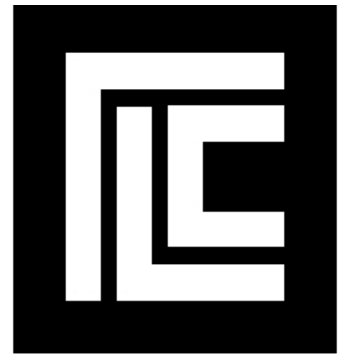


Gospel: Palm Sunday

April 10, 2022

Luke 4:18-21; 7:18-20; 17:21



This morning we continued our series, Gospel. When Jesus arrives, things change. Jesus brings hope into the world and is insistent that because he has arrived, redemption is here. The Kingdom of God is here. Yet we hold this in tension with the brokenness of our world. Palm Sunday is about Jesus' presence and the promises that come along with it. Easter is about Jesus' power to fulfill those promises.

We began Sunday by sharing something that we are “slightly-above average” at. What is your thing? This is your chance to brag on yourself!

Digging Deeper

- In the second passage above, John the Baptist asks the question, “Jesus are you the one, or should we wait for another”? Have you ever wanted to ask a similar question in your life? How did you respond to this? What do you make of Jesus' response?
- Every chance that he gets, Jesus insists that the kingdom of God is here, and with his arrival, there is hope and redemption. How does this resonate with you?
- We closed by imagining a place or space that represents the destruction/sinfulness/brokenness/heartache we might be experiencing and were asked to hold onto that for this coming Easter Sunday. What is the image you are holding onto?
