
James: Doers of the Word

Digging Deeper

Are there any systems that keep people in situations of poverty that you have first-hand experience with? Any that you have questions about? Are there any that you are passionate about engaging in?
 - O As we discuss this, remember James first instruction: quick to listen, slow to speak, slow to become angry.
- God's word is intended to be a mirror. In what ways did Sunday's message, and this text serve as a mirror for you? What is it revealing or reminding of for you?
- Did you take the mirror challenge (every minute spent looking at the mirror, spend reading James)? How has it gone?
