- On Sunday, Toran mentioned some of the other “creation myths” that existed around the time that Genesis was written. These offer a much different picture of creation and humanity’s purpose. How did this shed new light on Genesis and the reading above for you?
- If you don’t know who you are, you’ll never know what to do, how to do it, or why you do it. We were created to be kings and queens, and given a job to do. When we know who we are, our identity, it shapes what we do, why we do it and how we do it. How does this impact your work and the perspective you carry into it?
- God wants to actively partner with you. Do you believe this? How have you seen this to be true? Is there anything that makes it hard for you to believe this?



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
