
Gospel: Humanity

This morning we continued our new series, Gospel. A gospel is an explanatory narrative that gives you hope to live in the world. On Sunday, Dr. Burge walked us through the Gospel that Scripture provides: Creation, Fall, Redemption, and Restoration. We focused in on the first two words this past Sunday.

- Dr. Burge walked us through the second circle and word—Fall. Something is broken in creation and humanity. He showed a few images to tweak our memory of this reality. How did this make you feel? How did you respond?
- Something is wonderful, but burdened; beautiful, but broken about creation. We are in need of a rescue. How does this resonate with you? How did you respond to Sunday's message as a whole?
