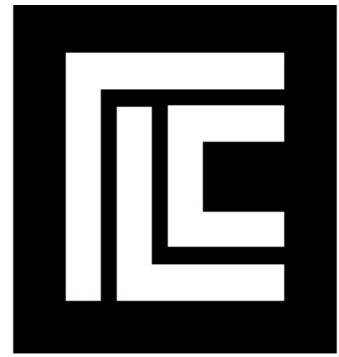


Novel: a vision for the next chapter
